Sunday, July 25th – Lesson 2

Jesus, the Servant • Matthew 20: 20-28
Like Jesus, we can serve others with caring hearts.

Memory Verse: Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not men.
Ephesians 6:7

Last week, we discussed how Jesus was favored by God and by man. We listened to the story about Jesus of when he was a young boy. Jesus, Mary & Joseph were in Jerusalem for the Passover festival when Mary & Joseph couldn't find their son Jesus. His parents thought they had lost him but Jesus was in the temple talking to the religious teachers (as he was called to do by his Heavenly Father). His parents were worried, but happy they found him. We shared in class our feelings of what it might feel like to be lost and what Jesus mother must have felt when she couldn't find him. We learned that Jesus was obedient to his parents and wanted to please them by being respectful. Jesus went back home with Mary & Joseph. We shared with one another ways we could be obedient with our own parents. The children came up with awesome responses! The children learned we can follow Jesus example and choose to please God and our moms and dads too. Our first 'homework' was sent home and is due back on Sunday, the 25th.

This weeks lesson is called Jesus - the servant. Children will learn about serving others through our welcome activities and the All Aboard For Bible Truth lesson. Children will study Matthew 20 and find out that Jesus came as a servant. We will use some sharing time to help the children connect with the story and give them an opportunity to share their experiences. We will also learn our new scripture Ephesians 6:7 for guidance, protection and encouragement.

Please help us as we do life together through our children. Several ways we practice learning scripture is through placing our words on poster boards and also by writing one word at a time on a piece of paper. Another great way is placing index cards on a ring and keeping the cards somewhere easily accessible - kitchen, car, etc. We will practice our verses on Sunday and continue through the month.
