Jesus, Teaching Truth • Luke 6:43-45
Jesus wants us to know and live the truth

Memory Verse: Your word is truth.

John 17:17

Last week, we discussed how we can serve others with caring hearts. We listened to the story about a mother who was proud of her sons, James & John who were followers of Jesus. Because the mom wanted good things for her two boys, she asked Jesus if her two sons could sit next to Him when they enter the Kingdom. The other 10 disciples heard of what was asked and started complaining. Jesus told them, whoever wants to be first has to serve others. Jesus told the disciples he came to serve, and that's the example we're to follow. The children discussed different ways they could serve and why sometimes we want to always be first. The children learned we can follow Jesus example and choose to please God and our moms and dads too. Our 'homework' was sent home and is due back on Sunday, August 1st. Our 'goodies' have arrived, so don't forget to bring back the homework.

This weeks lesson is called Jesus - Teaching Truth. Children will learn about knowing truth and living truthful through our welcome activities and the All Aboard For Bible Truth lesson. Children will study Luke 6 to discover that Jesus wants them to live lives of truthfulness inside and out.

We will use some sharing time to help the children connect with the story and give them an opportunity to share their experiences.

We will also learn our new scripture John 17:17 for guidance, protection and encouragement. Please help us as we do life together through our children. Several ways we practice learning scripture is through placing our words on poster boards and also by writing one word at a time on a piece of paper. Another great way is placing index cards on a ring and keeping the cards somewhere easily accessible - kitchen, car. etc. We will practice our verses on Sunday and continue through the month.
